Heritage New Zealand Pouhere Taonga understands that St Paul's Church & Vestry, Arrowtown is undertaking a conservation repair and strengthening project for the buildings.

St Paul's Church & Vestry is a Category 1 historic place on the New Zealand Heritage List/Rārangi Kōrero, (No. 2123). The building is also scheduled on the Queenstown Lakes Proposed District Plan as a heritage item in Part 5 – Historic Heritage – Inventory of Listed Heritage Features with reference number 368.

The Otago/Southland Area office has provided heritage guidance on the repair and restoration of the Church and continues to do so.

The current project is to undertake replacement the roof underlay, repairing flashings, replace weather boards and repainting. In addition, the Church bell tower requires some strengthening work. This project will ensure that the church can continue to be used for the future whilst providing a safe environment for the community using the building and protecting the building for future generations.
