1.	<p><u>Speed Management</u></p> <p>The purpose of this item was to provide feedback submitted by Elected Members on the draft Speed Management Programme (SMP), following the 5 August Council workshop and to finalise speed limit changes to be included in the draft consultation document.</p> <p>The feedback discussed will be incorporated into the draft SMP before it returns to Council in November/December, post-election to seek approval to go to public consultation.</p> <p>Ms Chen (Civil Engineer - Transport) and Ms Tomlinson (Strategic Asset Manager) introduced the item and spoke to a presentation (Attachment A).</p> <p>Discussion</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Ms Chen and Ms Tomlinson discussed proposed speed increases and reductions across the district and asked Councillors for feedback to help inform the public consultation. Areas discussed included Cardrona Valley Road, Golf Course Road, Park Street and Mt Aspiring Road. 	None

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • There was robust discussion of speed limits on Ballantyne Road in Wānaka, with some Councillors wanting to increase the speed limit to 50km. • Councillors noted that QLDC staff need to explain the decisions of proposed speed changes to the community, so they understand the reasoning and help avoid potential frustration. • Discussion around the potential for the public consultation list to include roads that aren't being recommended to have speed limit changes for the public to provide feedback on, to get more holistic community feedback. • Ms Tomlinson and Ms Chen advised that depending on the number of changes that come out of the public consultation, there may need to be another Council Workshop for the incoming Council to work through. • Ms Tomlinson to liaise with Councillor Bartlett on the final list of roads having speed changes before going out for public consultation. <p><u>Attachments</u> <i>Attachment A: Proposed Speed Limits Material</i></p>
