**5** Without derogating from paragraph 4, the **OTAGO REGIONAL COUNCIL** is particularly interested in the Appellant's appeal on Chapter 3 Strategic Direction, Chapter 6 Landscapes and Rural Character, and Chapter 21 Rural Zone.

**6** The **OTAGO REGIONAL COUNCIL**—


6.1 Supports the relief sought to the extent necessary to:

(1) give effect to the Otago Regional Council's submission on Chapters 3, 6 and 21 of the PDP;

- (2) give effect to the relevant objectives and policies of the Operative Regional Policy Statement and the settled provisions of the Proposed Otago Regional Policy Statement;
- (3) avoid rural fragmentation;
- (4) provide for rural and tourist-related (tourist experience) activities.

6.2 Opposes the relief sought to the extent, if any, it goes beyond achieving the outcomes specified in 6.1.
