Submission on Queenstown Lakes District Council's 293 proposal relating to the Landscape Classification of the Clutha River/Mata Au Corridor

To: Queenstown Lakes District Council

NAME OF THE SUBMITTER:

SUBMISSION SUBJECT MATTER:

2. The Trust has been notified by the Queenstown Lakes District Council (**Council**) of a Section 293 Proposal to alter the mapping and landscape classification of the Clutha River/Mata Au

Corridor (Section 293 Proposal) to an Outstanding Natural Feature (ONF).

3. The Trust owns properties between the Clutha River/Mata Au and the Wanaka Airport which are affected by the Councils Section 293 Proposal. The Trust's land that is proposed to be

reclassified to ONF is shown in the plans attached as Appendix 1 to this letter and is held in

the following titles (together, the Trust Land):

(a) Lot 1 DP 25265;

(b) Lot 2 DP 26911;

(c) Lot 3 DP 26911;

(d) Lot 2 DP 22247;

(e) Lot 3 DP 22247;

(f) Lot 4 DP 22247;

(g) Lot 5 DP 22247;

(h) Lot 6 DP 22247;

(i) Lot 7 DP 22247; and

(j) Lot 8 DP 22247.

SUBMISSION OF THE TRUST

4. The Trust opposes the reclassification of the Trust Land to ONF.

Reasons for the Submission

5. As part of the Council's District Plan review relating to the Queenstown Lakes District's (**District**) Outstanding Natural Landscapes (**ONL**) and ONFs it became clear that expert

landscape witnesses before the Court considered the Clutha River/Mata Au and its immediate

enclosing banks to be an ONF.¹ The Court agreed with the landscape experts that the Clutha River/Mata Au is appropriately classified as an ONF.²

- 6. There has been debate as to the extent of the ONF boundaries of the Clutha River corridor. This debate has focused on a block of land owned by James Cooper on the opposite side of the Clutha River to the Trust Land (**Cooper Block**).³
- 7. Council's landscape architect Ms Mellsop considered that the wider Clutha River/Mata Au corridor should be classified as an ONL.⁴ The Court however held that the scarps and lower terraces of the Cooper Block are to be included in the ONF as they are intrinsically linked to the Clutha River/Mata Au ONF.⁵
- 8. Ms Mellsop's evidence also supported the Proposed District Plan Decisions Mapping ONL boundaries over the Trust Land.⁶ However, there does not appear to have been a determination of the Court in relation to the classification of the Trust Land. The Trust considers that this wider environment is different in character to the enclosing banks of the Clutha River/Mata Au.
- 9. The Court's decision on the Cooper Block is focused on the scarps and terraces present on the Cooper Block. These were considered to be highly legible and expressive of their historical relationship to the Clutha River by the Court.⁷ The Trust Land does not display the same characteristics as the Cooper Block and does not accommodate scarps or terraces of the same size. In most instances the Trust Land is located further from the river corridor than the Cooper Block and is not within the enclosing banks of the Clutha River/Mata Au.
- 10. The Trust considers that an independent landscape architect is likely to reach the same conclusion as Ms Mellsop and consider that that some or all of the Trust Land should not be included in the ONF.
- 11. As it appears that there has been no specific Court determination as to the classification of the Trust Land, it is unclear as to how the exact ONF boundaries over the Trust Land were arrived at by the Council in preparing the Section 293 application. The Council has not provided the Trust with this analysis.

12. The ONF classification over the Trust Land will impact the Trust's ability to develop and utilise

the land as a working farm due to ONFs being subject to more restrictive policies and rules than

ONLs.

13. For the reasons set out above the Trust considers that its land is more appropriately classified

ONL rather than ONF.

Preparation of Landscape Evidence

14. The notification letter the Trust received from Council on 21 September suggests landscape

evidence and/or an affidavit could be provided by the Trust to the Court. The Trust had no prior

knowledge of the Section 293 Proposal before receiving the above-mentioned letter on 21

September.

15. The Trust has therefore been unable to obtain and provide an affidavit from a landscape expert

within the very short timeframe specified by Council. The Trust submits that as a matter of

procedural fairness it should be given further time to analyse the evidence leading to the ONF

classification, peer review that, obtain advice from an independent landscape architect, if

necessary join the proceedings as a section 274 party and call evidence on the location of the

ONF boundaries that impact the Trust Land.

DECISION SOUGHT

16. The Trust seeks the following decision:

> (a) that the Section 293 Proposal is rejected and that the Proposed District Plan Decisions

Version mapping is retained over Trust Land.





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
