Introducing the Forward Works Viewer, a free, secure online mapping tool for anyone planning or managing projects, events or major activities in the Queenstown Lakes District.

## WHY INTRODUCE FORWARD WORKS?

Our district has experienced considerable and consistent growth over many years. While the COVID-19 pandemic may have altered our growth story, the outlook for the future is still strong. There are many capital works projects, residential subdivisions, commercial projects and large scale public events underway and planned for the near future. Introducing the Forward Works Viewer will allow everyone involved in large scale projects in the Queenstown Lakes District to take a holistic, collaborative approach to strategic planning and managing any effects on our people and environment.

Forward Works was developed to support a successful approach to recovery following the Canterbury earthquakes and has been more recently introduced in Auckland.



## HOW IT WORKS

You sign up for access and enter information about your planned works right at the start of the process. You're then able to review detail of other projects planned for the same area, consider any clashes then review and discuss any opportunities for coordination with other project / event managers or Council.

The best data is up to date data. The system will be available 24/7 allowing you to keep your project information current.

Potential for things like traffic management or trench digging to be done once to minimise community disruption and reduce costs

Improve coordination of projects, and gain awareness of what may be occurring around your event or project when you're in the early stages of planning.
