Ms Greenslade made a submission (#2249) on Chapters 24 & 27 of the notified Proposed Queenstown Lakes District Plan (**PDP**). Ms Greenslade is also a person who has an interest in the Appeal that is greater than the interest that the general public has, in that Ms Greenslade owns land directly affected by the PDP provisions the subject of the Appeal.
