QLDC response

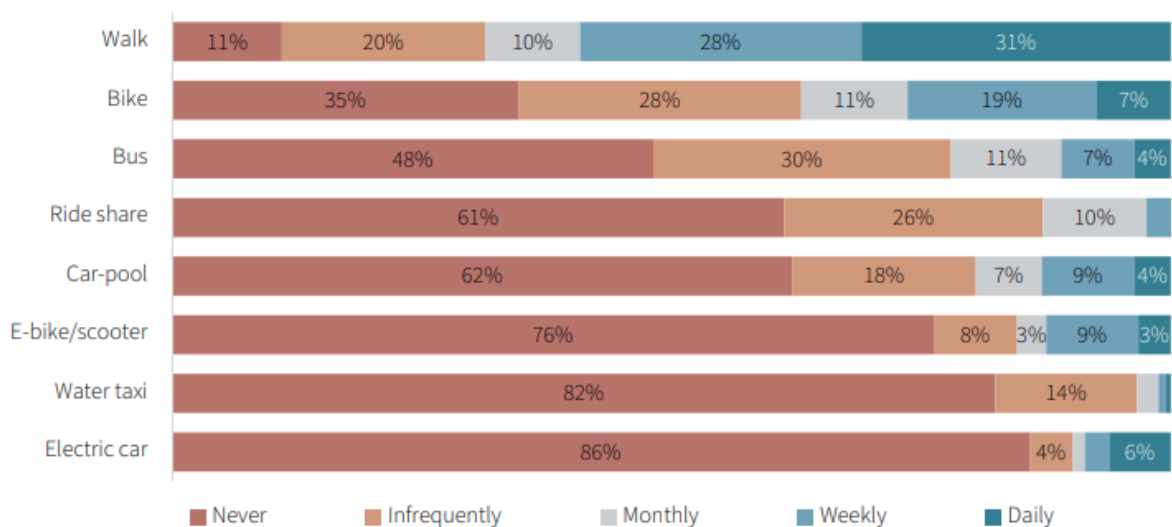
