What's happening next week

The team is working across multiple worksites. We've provided an update on each area below, so you know what to expect next week:

Looking sharp - new permanent line marking has now been completed at the Melbourne/Sydney Street intersection.

Melbourne Street

We have painted new road markings on the road and installed a pedestrian island crossing at the intersection of Melbourne Street and Frankton Road. We're now working on landscaping and planting garden beds.

Dublin Street

CLOSED

Our crew is underway with preparing this area for the concrete flush crossing, which provides a safe pedestrian crossing point. The road will remain closed for approximately 4 weeks. Access will be via Sydney/Melbourne intersection through to Hallenstein Street. We will update you with the opening date as soon as we have it.

Frankton Road

Traffic will remain on the hillside of Frankton Road next week. It will be a little quieter with most of our work taking place in isolated pockets during the day. Please follow the traffic and pedestrian signs and take extra care. We do have night works scheduled between 8-12 December to tidy up some areas along Frankton Road, and to install the last pedestrian island crossing and lane separation. (more info on that is contained in the separate night works notice, attached)

Sydney/Melbourne intersection

We need to install traffic islands on upper and lower Sydney Street. The intersection will remain open with stop/go in place during the week to facilitate the remaining work. The lights at the intersection will also become live and colourful. Landscaping will continue during the day.

Henry Street

CLOSED UNTIL FRIDAY 20 DECEMBER

We've completed the final kerb pour and almost finished with footpath preparations. We're set to lay asphalt here at the beginning of next week. Vehicle access to businesses remain via Robins Road onto Gorge Road. Designated parking spots are in place for Henry Street residents and businesses only in the area. Pedestrian access remains unaffected. Please follow the traffic and pedestrian signs and take extra care due to heavy truck movements.

Gorge Road/Turner Street

CLOSED UNTIL FRIDAY 20 DECEMBER

We are making good progress to raise all the manholes on the road to bring them up to the correct level in preparation for the final asphalt to be laid. We have started excavating the road for the flush crossing on Turner Street. Turner Street access remains with a lane adjustment in place. Access will be maintained for residents and businesses, with a one-way exit out of Gorge Road onto the Shotover/Stanley Street intersection.

Lower Ballarat Street

We are working to install as much of the upgraded stormwater pipe as possible, to cross Athol Street before Friday 20 December. As a reminder, there is no access to/from Athol Street from Ballarat Street. Entry into Athol Street for businesses and the KFC drive-through will be from Shotover Street. The coach stop on Athol Street has been relocated to Stanley Street.
