1.	<p><u>Quarterly Parks Update</u></p> <p>Snow Farm Toilet Many LTP submissions received re Snow Farm toilets but no budget for new toilets until 2026/27. Type of toilet at Snow Farm is limited because of location and inability to pump water.</p> <p>Dog Parks Suggestions of potential sites. Potential for an informal dog exercise area at Templeton Park in Albert Town (and other areas also suggested). Uncertain of priority.</p> <p>Wānaka Skate Park Lighting Cost is \$250-\$300K. RMP allows lighting up to 10.00am. Lighting of skate bowl for safety is different from facility lighting.</p> <p>Wānaka Watersports Carpark New bridge is complete. Concerns about inefficient parking. Install rocks to control parking (or something equally inexpensive)?</p> <p>Discussion about relocating bus parking to the showgrounds side. This would result in people having to cross the road but this is better use of plenty of road reserve on the showgrounds side.</p> <p>Thinning of foliage near Bullock Creek Project should be complete before Christmas 2024. Once complete, Board members to provide input on whether replanting is needed.</p> <p>Wildfire closure process Officers have reviewed closure process. In 2024/25 considering potential of closing trails but leaving access open at the bottom.</p> <p>Attachment: <i>Attachment A: Quarterly Parks Update (attached)</i></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Snow Farm Toilet: Staff to prepare costings of different toilet options. • Dog Parks Research needed to understand demand. No budget allocated at present. • Skateboard Park Lighting Staff to approach group to discuss co-funding option. Club may be able to deliver using in kind support and for lower overall cost than QLDC. • Wānaka Watersports Carpark Consider what practically can be done immediately with an overall design plan as a longer term objective.
