Notification of a Reserved Area for a Special Event

Public Notice is hereby given that pursuant to the Queenstown Lakes District Navigation Safety Bylaw 2018, Bylaw Clause 31 has been invoked to establish a reserved area to restrict all non-authorized vessels to enter the **Roaring Meg section of the Kawarau River**. During these times, a reserved area has been established for authorized event vessels only.

Reserved dates:

- 1 November 2024
- 4 November 2024 to 8 November 2024
- 12 November 2024 to 16 November 2024
- 18 November 2024 to 22 November 2024

Back-up dates (subject to weather): 23 November 2024, 25 November 2024 to 27 November 2024

Location: Kawarau River (1km above and below the Roaring Meg power station)

Regular rabbit control operation in Shotover Cemetery and Gibbston Reserve

Queenstown Lakes District Council (QLDC) has employed the services of a professional contractor to carry out rabbit control in Shotover Cemetery on Spence Road and Gibbston Reserve, to further reduce rabbit numbers and their negative impact on residential property and vegetation in the areas.

Control will be carried out in both areas at night on the last Friday of every month, starting on Friday 25 October and running through until the end of June 2025. These operations will begin at 8.00pm and are expected to take an estimated four hours to complete.

Experienced professional contractors will carry out the night shooting operation within a cordoned off area. Signage and personnel will be at all main entry points to ensure no one can enter the area during the operation.

- Please respect the cordon and DO NOT ENTER when signage and personnel are present.
- The cemetery and reserve will be closed when operations are underway. If members of the public are asked to leave the area for their safety, please do so.
- Police have been notified of this rabbit control operation.
- Please be aware that noise from firearms, which are suppressed, might be heard outside Shotover Cemetery Reserve and the Gibbston Reserve.
- In the event of wet weather, shooting will take place the following night.
